Glossary

Wristband - Wristbands are handed out on the first day of the kick-off. As a new student, you have to wear the wristband during the whole kick-off period to show that you are a student and allowed to participate in the kick-off.

Headband - A personal strip of fabric that every first-year student wears around their head to identify which association/section they are a part of.

Overall/åvve - The best garment a student can own! The overall is a colorful boiler suit that students in Sweden wear to show what subject they study. It is your most important garment during your study period. Wear it with pride! The overall contributes to community and joy whilst showing which association/section you belong to, since the overall has a different color depending on what you study.

Patches - To decorate your "åvve" (overall), you will of course need patches. You can get patches by participating in various events or buying your own. For example, there are special Facebook groups or websites where you can find different patches!

Fadder/Buddy - During the orientation week, there are students available to help you. Mentors (faddrar) are assigned a group of new students for whom they are responsible. Don't hesitate to seek help from your mentors during the kick-off!

Phösare - Usually, students in their third year or later. They serve the same function as mentors (faddrar), but typically do not have their own group of new students to look after. Phösare are also there to help you!

General - Each student association/section has at least three generals who have been elected to be responsible for planning the kick-off and ensuring everything is as good as possible for you new students. The easiest way to identify the generals is to look for those wearing some type of special headgear.

Generalmajor - General majors have the primary responsibility for ensuring that the kick-off goes as planned, that rules are followed, and that the new students, along with generals, mentors, and phösare, have a truly enjoyable time!

SKS - SKS stands for the Student Union in Sundsvall. More detailed information can be found in the previous section. We recommend that you become a member!

The Committee - The committee consists of generals, major generals, and SKS, who together plan the entire kick-off to ensure that new students have as memorable a start to their student life as possible!

Student Association - A student association represents one or several programs at the school. These associations (linjeföreningar and sektioner) work to enhance student life by organizing fun events and other activities. The boards of these associations are run by students - for students. Each association has its own color for their overalls ("åvve") and a mascot.

Section - Sections are mostly similar to the student associations. They also have their own color for their overalls and their own mascots. However, sections are part of SKS and are therefore not a separate entity. They delegate parts of their finances and specific administrative tasks to SKS.

Culture associations - Cross-program associations. Currently, Mid Sweden University in Sundsvall has two cultural associations: Borstmästeriet (BM) and Sundsvalls Åverallsällskap (SÅS).

The Commission/Kommissionen - The commission sees all, hears all, and knows all... This mythical entity is characterized by rumors and local legends. No one knows who they are or where they came from. All we know is that they usually visit the kick-off...

Rules during the kick-off

To ensure that the kick-off is a fun and safe introduction to the student-life in Sundsvall, some important rules have been enforced that everyone involved has to follow! Take contact with a fadder, phösare, general, generalmajor or SKS if someone violates a rule.

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR DRUGS - Drug use during the kick-off will be reported to the police without exception.

FORBIDDEN TO PRESSURE ANYONE TO DRINK ALCOHOL - Alcohol consumption is voluntary. No one should be forced to drink alcohol. Therefore, it is forbidden to encourage or pressure another student to drink alcohol. During our events, alcohol is always optional.

THE ALCOHOL LAW MUST BE FOLLOWED - It is considered providing alcohol to someone under 20 years old if you share alcohol with them. The person giving away the alcohol is always responsible for this and can be punished if not followed. Therefore, make sure to verify age or completely refrain from sharing alcohol.

ABSOLUTE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR DISCRIMINATION, BULLYING, OR SEXUAL HARASSMENT - All types of offenses that violate this will be reported immediately and may result in suspension from the kick-off. Be respectful and inclusive towards other students.

“NOLLEFRIDEN” MUST BE FOLLOWED - To prevent new students from feeling exploited or vulnerable due to power dynamics, sexual relationships between new students and mentors/generals/major generals are prohibited. It is not allowed to engage in any physical relationship with any of these individuals during the orientation week. This includes games and activities involving physical or sexual content.

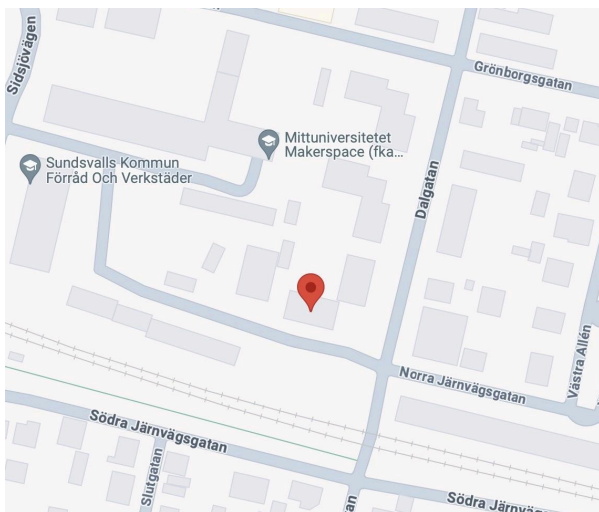
Find everywhere!

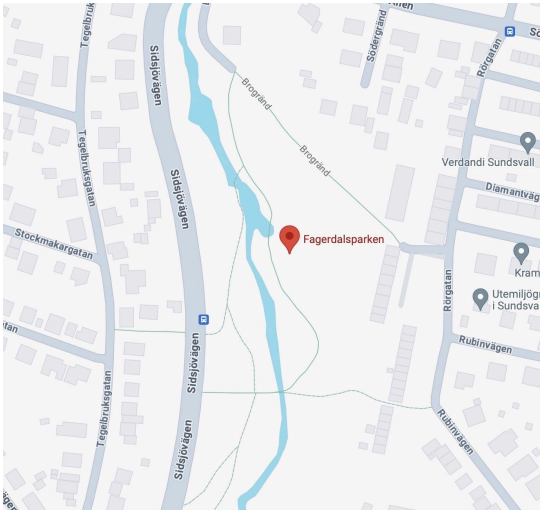
Dalgatan 14

Here are some of the student accommodations closest to the university. This area serves as a hub for many students, and a significant part of student life unfolds here!



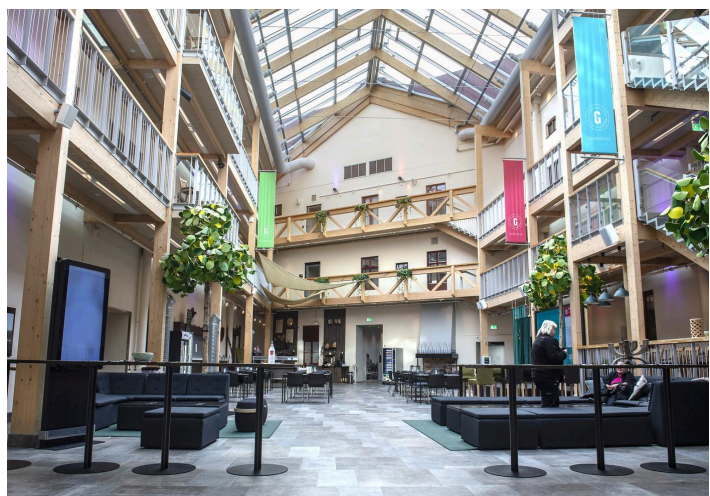
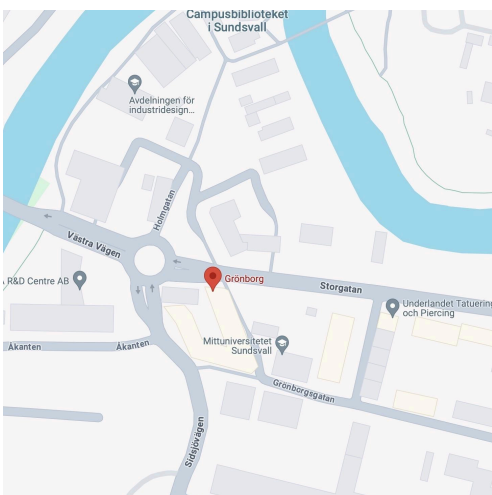
Fagerdalsparken

On the way up towards Sidsjön, you'll find this beautiful park where several events will be held. It features waterfalls, expansive open grassy areas, and plenty of seating.



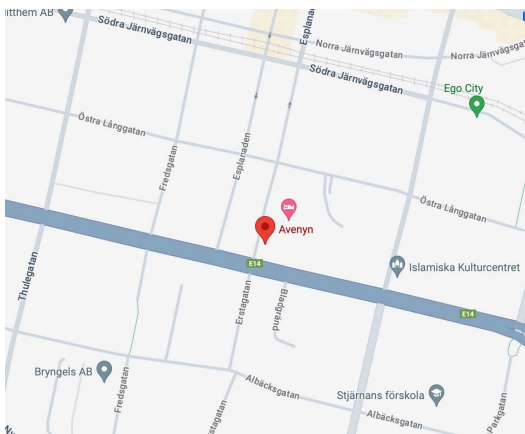

On the second floor of the Grönborg building, you'll find SKS and their office.



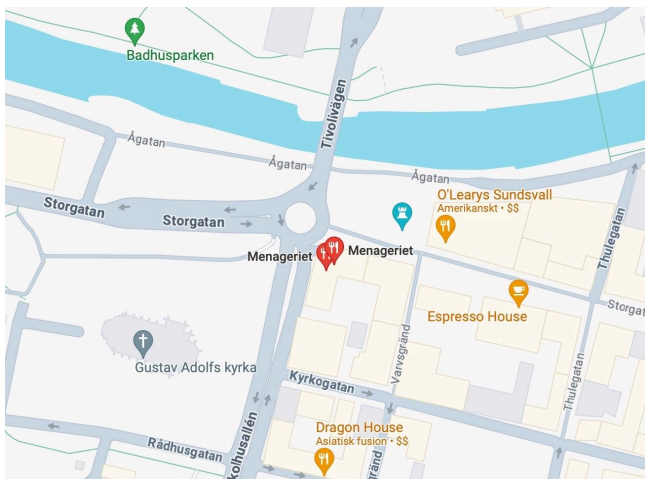
